PR-Z 153 · Zaragoceta-Miraflores Route



Hiking and cycling route (high level) along the Guadalope valley that allows one to know the rural neighborhoods of Caspe located in the historical huertas of Miraflores, Percuñar, and Zaragoceta. The route is very interesting from a scenic and environmental point of view, as it runs close to the river and crosses places of high natural content such as the grove of Barberán, the Salto de la Cierva, or the Miraflores cliff. This route is an excellent opportunity to get to know the nature surrounding the lower Guadalope and one of the best invitations to walk in the region.



The route departs from Zaragoceta along the canal service road, and joins the track on the left, towards the river. It crosses the Guadalope river by the Palanca del Tío Tacos and, on the opposite bank, it takes a path that, following the course of the river, meanders through the riparian undergrowth and the area of the fluvial escarpment next to the riverbed.

After passing a cliff, it joins a farm road and continues along a track until it connects with the path in front of the ford of Torre Barberán. The path goes over the escarpment of the river and leads to an agricultural road that borders the limits of some farms. The road becomes blurred at an old gravel pit, where it continues as a path.

It connects with PR-Z 152 under the cliff of Masatrigos, it crosses over the historical bridge of the same name. It separates from the aforementioned route and continues along a track upstream along the river.

It passes next to an old furnace of crucibles. The track crowns an ascent and goes along the edge of the cliff of Miraflores, a panoramic viewpoint of the valley, and the huertas of the Guadalope.

After the houses in the Miraflores neighborhood, the road connects with the canal service road, which is further on along a good track in the direction of Torre Barberán. It turns to the right following some ruts that cross a sandy meadow and go into the riparian undergrowth. At the end of the grove, it borders a field of olive trees and continues along the path, arriving at the Salto de la Cierva, a fluvial place of natural interest.

The path ends at a farm road and connects again with the service road of the canal, which it leaves further ahead to, on a slightly worse road, surround the Vuelta de Roldán and, already by a service road, the route ends.
